Rudy Rabbinge is University Professor in Sustainable Development and Food Security at Wageningen University and is Chair of the Science Council of the Consultative Group on International Agricultural Research (CGIAR). Biologist by training, he worked the past 30 years in various functions on the ecologisation of agriculture. As professor of Theoretical Production Ecology (1978-1998) he initiated different major programs in the application of basic knowledge and insight in innovative processes for primary productions and systems approaches in agricultural research. He was Dean of Wageningen Graduate Schools (1998-2006). He has led various missions and agricultural programs in developing countries, served as editor of several journals, published more than 200 scientific publications, five text books and more than 200 other publications. He served on the Board of Trustees (BoT) of 6 Centres of the CGIAR and was chairman of the IRRI's BoT (1995-2000), member of the Prime Ministers Scientific Council for the Government Policy (1988-1998), senior advisor for the minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Nature Management (1992-1999) and is at present Chairman of the Royal Institute of the Tropics, member of the Board of Directors of the Alliance for a Green Revolution in Africa (AGRA) and Bibliotheca Alexandrina and Member of the Board of various international agribusiness firms.
