Ton Dietz is professor of human geography at the University of Amsterdam, responsible for research and teaching with regard to 'environment and development'. He was scientific director of CERES, the Dutch/Flemish research school for resource studies for development between 2002 and 2007. He is vice chair of the Netherlands Research Foundation (NWO), WOTRO/Science for Global Development, member of the NWO unit Vulnerability, Mitigation and Adaptation; member of the Task Force of the Development Policy Review Network and of the organization responsible for publishing the Broker (see www.thebrokeronline.eu). He co-initiated the World Connectors (see www.worldconnectors.nl) and the website Global Connections. He is also member of the Board of ETC International.

His research interests are: institutions for access to natural resources; rural development interventions; dryland development, adaptation to climate change, and pastoralism. He defended his PhD in 1987 and received an honorary doctorate of Moi University in Eldoret, Kenya, in 2007. He supervised and still supervises a variety of research and PhD projects with regard to tropical rainforests in Africa, Asia and America.
