4. *Video and slide presentations*, rolling/ongoing
5. *Living landscape graffiti wall*, with orienting questions
6. *Voting box*, with backgrounders, voting cards, etc.
7. *'Quote of the hour' / 'Question of the hour'*, on the insider or outside walls
